Privacy Policy



Overview

At Greyhound Gap we are committed to maintain the trust of everyone who interacts with us for whatever reason. We do not sell or market any personal information and we do not compile lists for marketing purposes. Neither do we trade any private information with other organisations without express permission.

Adopting/Applying to Adopt or Foster

Collecting relevant personal information from those people who apply to adopt/actually adopt one of the dogs that belong to Greyhound Gap is essential for the adoption process and post adoption support. The information collected is securely kept and is only visible to our trusted administration team, the information supplied will not be used for any other purposes. We keep this information indefinitely, as stated, in our data protection statement on both the pre-adoption form and the adoption agreement, this is to safeguard the future of the dogs.

Requests from other rescues

We may, very occasionally, be asked for information about your home visit by another rescue. We will not disclose your home visit report without your consent.

Safeguarding exceptions

The only exception to the above points would be in the event that a dog adopted by you from Greyhound Gap became lost and the microchip number showed that we had an interest in the dog. We may, on occasion, be contacted by the police or a vet to verify ownership of the dog.

We do not use cookies on our web site and do not use or collect information about you by using this method.
